Victorian Easter Basket Instructions

- 1. Print box onto heavy white or pastel-colored card stock.
- 2. Cut around the edges carefully with scissors, a craft knife or a paper cutter.
- 3. Fold the panels with the roses on them first, following the dotted lines. Crease the folds with a bone folder, burnisher or the side of a pen. (If you use the side of a pen, make sure to cover the creased area with a piece of paper so you dong make any scrape marks.)
- 4. Fold the panels with the rabbit on them, following the instructions in number 3.
- 5. Pinch the corner pieces toward the center of the box, and then crease them.
- 6. Glue the corner pieces to the sides to hold the box together. You'd need to glue the fold to the box and then put a little glue in the fold to hold it in place.
